

St. Mary's Grade School Dress Code Policy **Kindergarten through 6th grade**

A student's appearance should reflect the impression that formal learning is important enough to call for neatness in dress. The development of self-respect, self-discipline, motivation, school unity and pride, modesty and other Catholic values are critical to the formation of all St. Mary's students. It is important the students take pride in their appearance, always remembering that by wearing it inside and outside the classroom and the school, they are representing the school. Their dress and behavior should be a credit to God, themselves, and the school community.

Shirts

- ▲ Solid white and solid navy blue top with the St. Mary's emblem ordered through the school.
- ▲ Undershirts are allowed as long as they are solid white or solid navy.
- ▲ White and navy shirts with "St. Mary's Catholic School" imprint are acceptable.

Bottoms ~ Allowed Only:

- ▲ A dri-fit/polyester material or loose knit pant in solid navy blue with no stripes or colored zippers
- ▲ Solid navy blue leggings only under a skirt or jumper
- ▲ Loose fitting cargo pants, casual dress pants, loose fitting capris, skirt/skort, jumpers, and shorts in either a solid navy or khaki

- ▲ Longer length athletic shorts and dri-fit pants with a logo no larger than a fist are acceptable.
- ▲ Shorts are not allowed on Mass days.

Sweatshirts

Sweatshirts in white or navy blue with the St. Mary's emblem ordered through the school.

Sweaters (optional)

Sweaters must be either a solid white or solid navy.

Shoes

Due to safety reasons, flip flops and sandals without a heel strap are not allowed.

St. Mary's Junior-Senior High School Dress Code **7th grade through 12th grade**

It is important for the students to take pride in their appearance, always remembering that by wearing it inside and outside the classroom and the school, they are representing the school. Shirts

- White or black top with school emblem ordered through the school.
- Undershirts and camisoles are allowed as undergarments as long as they are solid white or solid black.

Bottoms

- Loose fitting cargo pants, casual dress pants, loose fitting capris, skirts, or shorts in solid black or solid khaki. Options for bottoms are available at the St. Mary's store through Land's End (landsend.com/school). Instructions for ordering through Land's End are on the back of this sheet.
- Longer length athletic shorts with a fist size logo is permissible.
- Solid black leggings are allowed under a skirt only.
- Shorts are not allowed on Mass days.

Sweatshirts

White or black sweatshirt with school emblem ordered through the school.

Sweaters (optional)

Sweaters must be either a solid white or solid black.
