# Strategic Plan Goals Achieved for 2023-2024:


- Offered Physics to our high school science department electives.

- Installed new sound and light boards, in addition to new stage lighting in our auditorium.


## Strategic Plan Goals for 2024-2025:


- Add a robotics club for grades 3-5 and 6-8.
