Based on the novel Matilda by the talented Roald Dahl, Matilda Wormwood (Natalie Fischer, daughter of Adam ('01) and Melissa (Brau**lick '01))** is a little girl with incredible curiosity, an exceptional mind and a bold imagination - and, unfortunately, the worst family in the world. 

Donations to the Annual Appeal fund help to further subsidize teacher salaries so that we can make every effort to maintain competitive salaries for our faculty and staff. This year, our goal is \$175,000 and as I write this we are at \$60,538. <u>Please prayerfully consider a contribution to help us make our goal by June 30, 2023</u>.

It is good to mention an act of generosity that I have not seen elsewhere that has been happening here for the last five or so years. Each year, we have some benefactors who give a Christmas bonus especially to the faculty. This year four different families/ companies gave a combined \$32,000 that was then divided out to the faculty, providing a nice reminder to them of how much they are appreciated!


