Minnesota History students started the year by researching what makes Minnesota unique. We learned about the history of several companies and sports franchises that call Minnesota home. Students then researched Minnesota and were able to explore what makes Minnesota a state to be proud of.

Students then began exploring evidence of the earliest cultures to live in Minnesota. The 6th graders were able to travel to Jeffers Petroglyphs to examine the petroglyphs and other artifacts that Minnesota's early Native Americans used.

This quarter, students have also learned about Minnesota's physical geography and key physical features. The 6th grade recently began their BizTown preparation. We are scheduled to go to BizTown on November 15. There are several weeks of lessons to prepare students for this amazing hands-on opportunity.
