St. Mary's Brings a Fairy Tale to Life with "Cinderella"



This year's production of *Cinderella* took the stage March 20–22, bringing the beloved fairy tale to life with a talented cast directed by **George Hirschboeck** and assistant directors **Sarah Forster** and **Matthew Loyd**. The story centers on Cinderella, played by **Josie Helget** (daughter of **Rick and Becky (Wagner '92)**), a kind and gentle young woman who, following the death of her father, finds herself at the mercy of her cruel stepmother, portrayed by **Kiauna Suess** (daughter of **Mike and Kristy (Forster '00)**), and two mean stepsisters (**Grace Hoffmann**, daughter of **Brad ('90)** and **Lynn (Schneider '94)** and **Natalie Fischer** (daughter of **Adam ('01)** and **Melissa (Braulick '01)**).

When the royal family announces a grand ball — one with the very intention of finding a bride for the prince — Cinderella dreams of attending, only to be shut out by her spiteful stepmother. Just when all hope seems lost, her Fairy Godmother, brought to life by **Reese Hoffmann** (daughter of **Rusty ('91)** and **Tiffany (Bertrand '94)**), appears with a wave of her wand and a heart full of encouragement and led by her guardian angel, the dove (**Millie Lax**, daughter of **Mike Lax ('02)** and **Cheyenne Runck**).



With a little magic and a lot of belief, she transforms a gilded pumpkin into a gleaming coach, reshapes a handful of mice (**Scarlett Armbruster**, daughter of **Adam ('00)** and **Karlyn; Elizabeth Currans**, daughter of **Kevin and Marnee (Schwab '93)**; **Nell Weiss**, daughter of **Bryan and Naomi (Walter '99)** and **Kate Windschitl**, daughter of **Gary ('89)** and **Rachel**) into temporary horses and her cat, **Charles (McCoy Marti, son of Dell and Cindy)** into the coachman — complete with a stunning ballgown

and iconic glass slippers. The only catch? The magic vanishes at the stroke of midnight.



At the ball, Cinderella captures the heart of the charming Prince Christopher, played by **Charlie Hoffmann** (son of **Andy ('96)** and **Heather (Heiderscheidt '96)**). His parents, the dignified King Maximilian (**Jack Windschitl**, son of **Gary ('89)** and **Rachel**) and the gracious Queen Constantina (**Kiara Murphy**, daughter of **Craig and Amanda (Spaeth '03)**), have long hoped their son would find his perfect match — and it seems he may have done just that. But as the clock inches toward midnight, Cinderella races from the ballroom, leaving behind nothing but a single glass slipper on the palace steps.

Back home, Cinderella endures the continued cruelty of her stepmother — but her Fairy Godmother returns once more, this time with a message that goes beyond magic: trust in love, and let the prince see who you truly are. Meanwhile, Prince Christopher and his devoted page, **Lionel (Tyler Mathiowetz, son of Scott ('95)** and **Kayla**), set out across the kingdom on a determined search for the mysterious woman whose foot fits the delicate slipper. When the prince finally finds Cinderella, the slipper — and their love — fits perfectly, and the two are joyfully reunited and wed!
